PHYSICAL DEMANDS OF THIS PROFESSION--

This profession requires no heavy lifting. Professions for Cosmetology Operators, Instructors, and Shampoo Specialists requires standing 85% of the time, walking 10% of the time, and sitting 5% of the time. Professions for Manicure Specialists requires standing 5% of the time, walking 10% of the time, and sitting 85% of the time.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS OF THIS PROFESSION--

LEAVE OF ABSENCE POLICY

All leaves of absences must be requested in writing by the student in a signed and dated format. However, if unforeseen circumstances prevent a student from providing a prior written request, the institution may grant the student's request for a leave of absence. In this case, the leave will be documented in the student file and the written request is requested at a later date. Leaves of absence must be approved by the director of the school. A leave of absence and any subsequent leaves of absence may not exceed 180 days in any 12-month period. A student not returning to school at the end of a leave will be withdrawn the program with the last date of attendance being the withdrawal date and the loan repayment grace period will begin as of that date.
